Award Guidelines

The “LEADERSHIP AWARD” of the American Society of the Italian Legions of Merit has been established to identify, recognize and reward personalities who have distinguished themselves for their work in North America in the cultural, humanitarian, philanthropic, artistic, economic, commercial or financial fields.

The “LEADERSHIP AWARD” is conferred by the Board of Directors of the American Society of the Italian Legions of Merit and by the presiding President of the Society.

The “LEADERSHIP AWARD” will be assigned following a unanimous decision of the Board of Directors of the American Society of the Italian Legions of Merit, which can act on its own initiative or upon formal recommendation letters from no less than three members of the ASILM.

The Board of Directors of the American Society of the Italian Legions of Merit will not award more than five awards per year.

The Board of Directors of the American Society of the Italian Legions of Merit may revoke the recognition at any time, in the event the awarded recipient becomes unworthy.

The Awardee will receive the “LEADERSHIP AWARD” diploma.
